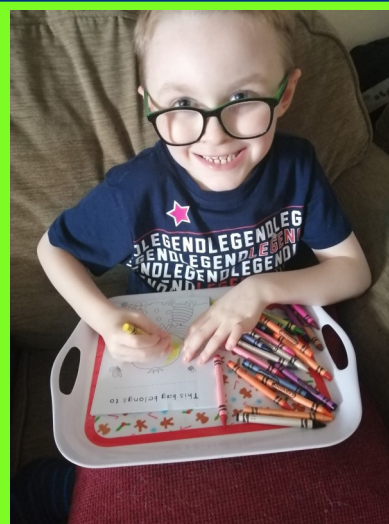




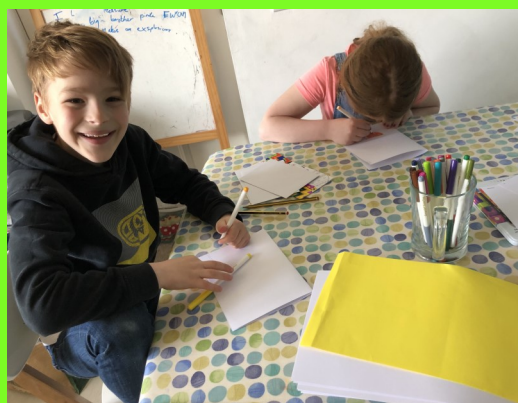
Tibberton and Hindip School News

Lord, may we all know your love.

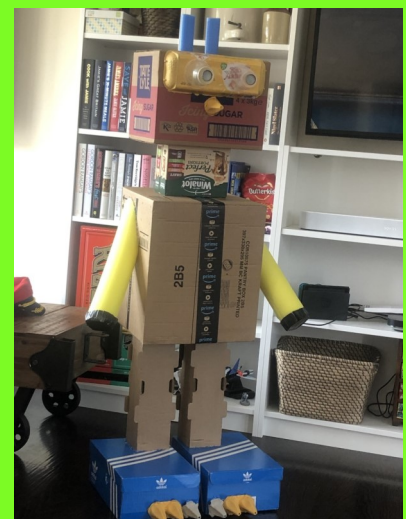
Its breadth, its length, its height, its depth.
